- Please attend the registration on Saturday evening 5 – 7pm where we will note your attendance and provide your race number. The bar is open and we have some local music.

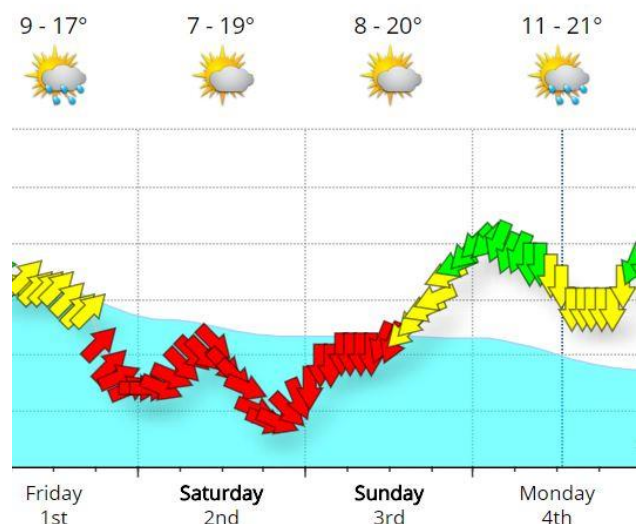
Time-table is attached but a little more info about food and entertainment for Sunday –
