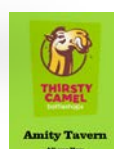

Everyone is welcome to participate.

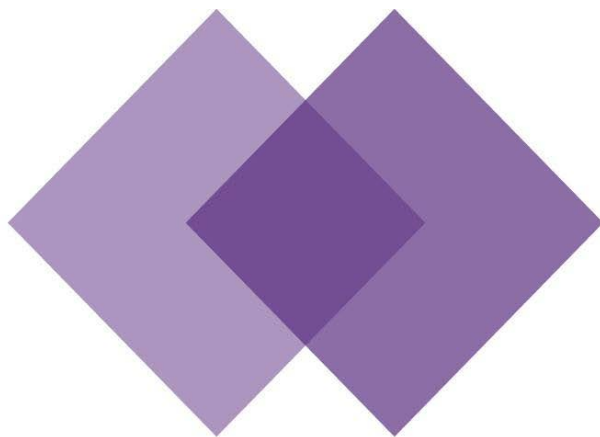

DENMARK COUNTRY CARNIVAL – AUSTRALIA DAY LONG WEEKEND

The Country Carnival at Denmark's Ocean Beach is due to be held on the Australia Day weekend Commencing Saturday January 26th. The basic program is as follows:-

Entries for Competitors from U8's through to U15's must be communicated by a Parent to the Age Group Managers. At the same time, AGM's will need to know what events your child would like to be entered into. Entries for U16's through to Seniors need to be communicated to Andrew Duffield via email Andrew.duffield@mainroads.wa.gov.au.

Entries close **Sunday January 20th**, so please make sure you register **ASAP**.

Given the enormous combined cost for competition entries, the club is now introducing a 50% contribution towards competitors entry fees. These fees must be paid either online or at the uniform shop on a Sunday morning **prior to close of Entries January 20th**. Please ensure you refer to your surname, and DCC (Denmark Country Carnival) if you are paying online, and email finance@albanysurfclub.com.au to confirm.

50% of Fees per competitor as follows:-

- Little Nippers - \$5 (each competitor, not event)
- Junior - \$7.50
- Senior & Cadets - \$10
- Boats - \$10

As the carnival is being held relatively close-by, the club has not organised to stay in Denmark.

Entry Fee: \$10 per competitor per series event; irrespective of categories entered.

Entries: Entries will close **Monday 22 January, 11pm before event**. Clubs will be responsible for entering their competitors using the SLSWA online entry system and will be invoiced directly for entries at the end of the month.

It is a requirement that teams entered into events are identified by a crew name which remains consistent throughout the season (e.g. J Crew, City Red, Cottesloe Rush, Scarboro Black). This will ensure errors in recording are minimised.

Crew names can now be entered using the online system via the following steps:

- Log into the online entry system
- Before selecting “Entries” on the event home page click on “Team Names”
- Team names for each event category can now be entered
- Once team names are entered click on the “Return to Carnival Home” option and continuing entering competitors as previously

Pre-Race Briefing: A briefing for sweeps will take place at **7:30am**. During the briefing competitors will be notified of any changes to the race course, safety requirements, program of events/starting order, course, craft/equipment requirements, start instructions and finish requirements.

Competitor award/proficiency requirements: All competitors entered in the series event must be proficient Bronze holders. It is the clubs responsibility to ensure any competitor entering the event has the necessary requirements for the category they are entered into. No competitor is permitted to compete in Surf Boat competition until reaching the age of 16 years.

Water Safety: North Cottesloe SLSC are to supply an IRB Driver and Crew (with DPF’s) from 7:45am and Swanbourne SLSC are to supply IRB Driver and Crew (with PDF’s) from 10:15am until the conclusion of the event including assisting with pack up.

Entries to be completed online at www.mybeach.com.au → Members → Surf Sports → Entries. Entries will close **Monday 21 January, 11pm before event**. Clubs will be responsible for entering their competitors using the SLSWA online entry system and will be invoiced directly for entries at the end of the month.

Competitor award/proficiency requirements: All nipper competitors entered in water event must have completed a preliminary skills evaluation and competition skills evaluation for their age group and have these submitted in surfguard prior to close of entries. Competitors that **only** participate in beach events do not require the Junior Competition Skills Evaluation and can be entered into “**Beach Events only entry**”. It is the club’s responsibility to ensure any competitor entering the event has the necessary requirements for the category they are entered into. **Competitor caps and hi-vis Engine lycra vests are compulsory.**

It is our intention to trial wristbands at this event for the Nipper competitors. Please note if we proceed with this trial competition numbers will not be issued.

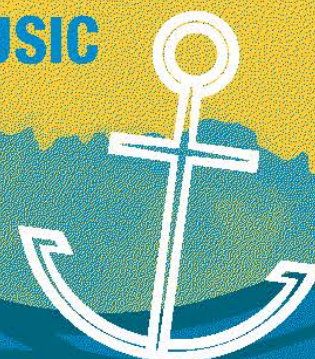
